

## Spotlight on melanoma

Australia has the highest rate of melanoma in the world.

It is also the 3rd most commonly diagnosed cancer in Australia, and every year, approximately:

- 17,000 Australians are diagnosed with melanoma, and
- 1,400 Australians lose their life to melanoma.

By 2030 the number of melanoma survivors is expected to increase by 83% to 348,000 Australians.

That's why we're calling on the government to implement our five-point action plan.
